We work to improve their quality of life, uphold their rights, and restore dignity to their lives. We develop initiatives that promote active aging, ensure their well-being, and foster socialization and community integration.



We strengthen collaboration with the national government, the Province of Buenos Aires, the City of Buenos Aires, companies, and organizations by donating medications and clothing to hospitals and NGOs.




We support the circular economy by receiving all types of donations, which are then sold to generate funds for the Foundation's social programs.

Aid Map


We provide direct assistance to 4,600 people and reach over 50,000 people through our network, distributing medications and essential goods across the country.
